

Resorts already eye summer with job fairs

It may be windy and rainy this week, but some of the biggest Strip resorts are preparing for summer with hiring events to staff their pools and dayclubs.

MGM Resorts International is looking to hire more than 1,000 seasonal employees specifically to work poolside. The company is seeking lifeguards, attendants, cabana hosts, cocktail servers, cooks, food servers, bartenders, receptionists, security officers, massage therapists and other positions.

The MGM career fair will be from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Wednesday, Jan. 11, in the Oceanside Ballroom of Mandalay Bay's South Convention Center. Parking is free for applicants (pick up a voucher at the event); MGM asks candidates to park in the Convention Center parking garage and take the escalators to the Oceanside Ballroom.

The jobs are temporary, but seasonal jobs can translate into permanent positions, company officials noted in a press release. Interviews will be conducted during the [event](#), and some applicants could be hired on the spot.

Just like the pool workers, to be considered for an appointment, candidates have to fill out an online application at caesarsjobs.com.

Wynn Resorts will hold a casting call for cocktail servers, server assistants, VIP hosts, bartenders, apprentice bartenders and security for XS, Surrender, Encore Beach Club and Intrigue.

The two-day event is Thursday, Jan. 12, and Friday, Jan. 13, in the Latour Ballroom at Wynn. But once again, they must fill out an [online application](#) first. Bartenders and servers must have swimwear for the casting call.
